Additional, mid-day support would be 11:00 am - 1:00 pm as needed to help with the extended day transition.

The ideal candidate will have a desire to work with young children in a social constructivist classroom and be flexible in meeting the needs of our programs. A bachelor's degree is required in early childhood education, child development, or a related field with experience working with children from 2 - 5 years old along with additional requirements set forth by our licensing body, the Department of Child and Family Services.
